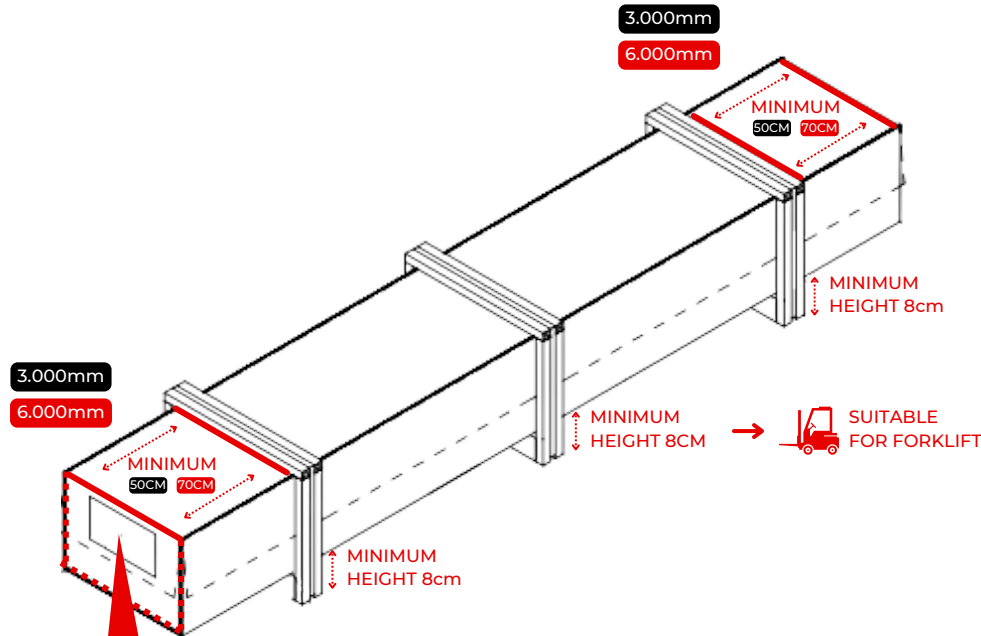


Profile/Bar packaging requirements



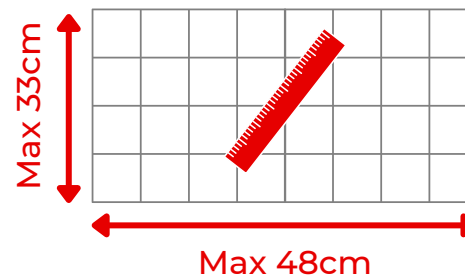
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Profiles (6.000mm) must **always** be packed with **paper interleaves**.
- Bars (3.000mm) can be packed without paper interleaves.
- Material must be packed according the positive/negative examples on page two.

Label must...

- ... be placed in both ends
- ... be neutral
- ... state Alumeco's PO number
- ... state material dimensions
- ... state weight & PC
- ... state the charge number
- ... state alloy & temper
- ... state the colli number

Packaging outside dimensions



Full profiles
Weight
1.000KG
+/- 20%

Open profiles
Weight
500KG
+/- 20%

Good & less good examples

Flat bars should be packed in different direction to increase stiffness, when lifted. Material always to be paper interleaved.



Packaging should be all around material.



A top layer must protect the top of the material.



Wood must not be placed closer than 50cm (3.000) and 70cm (6.000) from the edge of the colli.
